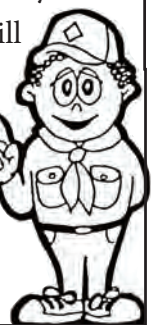

MILLION DOLLAR DIP

- 5 green onions, finely chopped

Serve in a festive bowl with chips, crackers or raw veggies.




• Nights Alive -
