'GATEWAY OF HOPE' HOSTS LANGLEY'S GOLDEST NIGHT OF THE YEAR WALK

Organizers Hope You'll Join this National Fundraising Walk for Homelessness

For the sixth year, the Salvation Army Gateway of Hope will be hosting the Coldest Night of the Year Walk in Langley on Saturday, February 23rd. They hope to raise \$25,000 with at least 300 walkers participating, along with community sponsors.

If you aren't familiar with the national family-friendly event, Coldest Night of the Year is a fundraiser to help serve hungry, homeless and hurting people through Salvation Army in Langley, and many organizations across Canada. Walkers of all ages can take part.

In a press statement, organizers said, "We walk through the cold and dark to declare our concern for people who have no home. We walk for those whose days are a battle to house and feed their families, and whose nights are filled with fear and frustration. We walk for people overwhelmed by isolation, guilt and despair. We walk humbly, realizing that anyone can lose their footing and then lose everything. Each step we take brings someone closer to safety, health and hope, as together, we raise funds for the Gateway of Hope, whose commitment and work transforms peoples' lives."

CNOY is intentionally planned for dusk during a cold winter's night to allow participants to experience a hint of the challenge faced by those homeless during winter. When you join by fundraising or volunteering as event support, you'll be contributing in a proactive, positive way to help the Gateway of Hope support those in need right here in Langley. There are three options for the walk: 2km, 5km and 10km.
