DID'YA KNOW THAT WHEN MEADOWS GETS SNOW?...

Under the TOL's Highway & Traffic Bylaw, residents must remove snow from sidewalks and walkways within 24 hours of the first accumulation. Cleared snow must remain on the property and cannot be pushed onto the

roadway. The bylaw is meant to protect the public, both physically and legally... worth noting that not removing snow can result in fines of up to \$100 per day.

CREEK STONE PLACE SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

Stepping Stone Community Services Society have had the new BC Housing facility located in the old Quality Inn up and running for a few months.

Creek Stone Place provides 49 self-contained units with 24/7 on-site supports for Langley residents who are transitioning out of homelessness. The supports include one hot meal a day, wellness checks, life skills training, connection and referral to community services and support groups. As well, there is an Intensive Case Management Team in the building.

The program uses a "housing first" approach that has shown that people are more likely to seek services and take steps towards personal stability if they have a home. A photo tour of the facility is available online:


